Class 2 Literacy

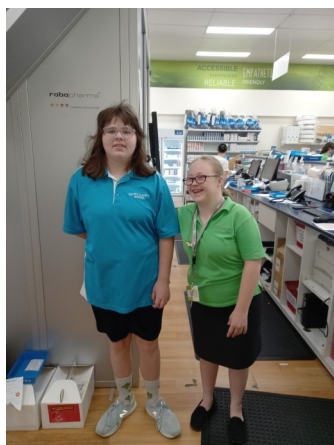
This term in Class 2 we look at various aspects of literacy. Each student completes these literacy activities each day.

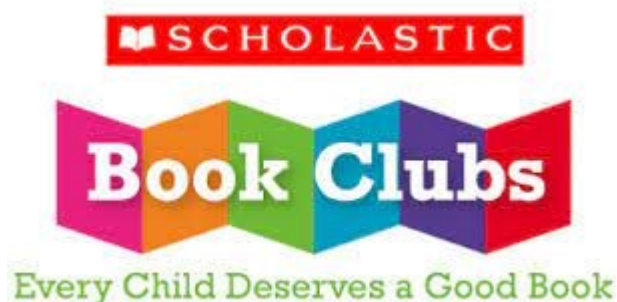
